Cookies Policy

The current policy is intended to inform you why we use "Cookies", what they do and what choices you have regarding their usage.

What are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are generated upon request from your browser to our web server and stored on your device. Usually their goal is to be able to identify your device and its behavior when you visit our sites.

There are two types of cookies - permanent and temporary (session cookies).

Session cookies are temporarily stored on your computer when you visit our Site but are deleted when you close the page.

Permanent cookies are stored as a file on your computer or mobile device for a longer period of time.

With the exception of cookies required for the operation of our site, we store cookies on your device only with your consent. If you do not want to accept cookies, you can adjust your browser settings - for more information about this, go to the bottom of this document.

If you prefer not to receive cookies while browsing our website, you can opt-out by setting your internet browser to warn before accepting a cookie or to reject cookies when your internet browser alerts you for their presence. You could also reject all cookies by turning them off by setting up your internet browser. Note that disabling cookies will affect the functionality of this and many other websites you visit. Disabled cookies will also typically disable certain features of our website.

Google Analytics

For the purpose of continuous functional optimization and maximum user-friendliness, we also use Google Analytics web analytics services. The data used for this purpose is exclusively of a non-personal nature.

Google Analytics: Google Analytics of Google Inc., 1600 Amphitheatre Parkway Mountain View, CA 94043, USA, uses cookies to analyze the use of our website services. In general, all data for your user behavior collected by the cookie is transmitted to a Google server in the USA and stored there. In case of activation of IP anonymity online services, Google will shorten your IP address within Member States of the European Union and European Economic Area. Only in exceptional cases the whole IP address will be transmitted to a Google server in the USA and shortened there. On behalf of the online service provider, Google will use this information to assess the use of online services, compile reports on these activities, and provide other services to the website operator related to the use of online services and Internet activities. The IP address transmitted by your browser within Google Analytics will not be asporpriate setting in your browser. In this case, however, you will not be able to fully use all the features of our online services. You can also prevent the collection of data generated by cookies and their use by Google, by downloading and installing the browser plug-in available at
